Circuit des curistes

A short easy circuit starting from the park, passing by magnificent villas from the past century as well as the bucolic banks of the Vernon stream.

11 Circuit des Curistes

As this circuit passes through two municipalities, the signpost colour changes according to the municipality concerned. **Blue** for Saint-Martin d'Uriage, **purple** for Vaulnaveys-le-Haut.


Blue then purple markings ----> Pass in front of the casino then cross the road to admire the beautiful fountain of the goddess Hygieia. Walk along the pedestrian area in front of the shops then cross the road to walk alongside the park. At the first roundabout cross over and continue straight on to the second roundabout. Continue straight on again and cross the road on the crossing in front of the new building just before the golf course. Continue walking away from Uriage for a few metres until turning right into chemin des Alberges. Walk past the beautiful early twentieth century houses to the crossroads of the Chemin de la Métallerie.



Purple and blue markings …? Take the small road on the right called chemin des Roux. Follow it to the chemin des Blancs on the left. At the end of chemin des Blancs turn right onto chemin Saint-Georges and follow it to the route du Prémol where you'll immediately turn right onto a very small path leading to the chemin de Mourachat and arrive at the Park.

Turn right onto the impasse de la Carrière, following the edge of the park. You'll follow the signs of circuit N° 1 (Le Bit, blue marking) only for this last part, to walk through the park to the starting point. When you arrive at the small bridge in the park, look out for the three bell towers (those of the Thermes, old electricity factory and the chateau), which are mysteriously aligned!)






The blue crosses correspond to the UTM-WGS84 kilometric grid - Mogoma map

In and around Uriage, many rural paths have been restored and incorporated into circuits of varying difficulty and length. Some can be walked in half a day, others take longer. They may be interesting for their views, for nature or for local heritage. Most are in the forest in a wild environment, despite the nearby urbanisation. Trail runners will be quick to realise that these circuits can be combined to create alternative routes to suit every level of runner.
